Criteria

- Professional Attained Achievement
- Community Service/Outstanding Service to Industry or Profession
- Integrity and Character
- Role Model
- Impact

Award Categories

- Distinguished Professional Achievement Award
- Distinguished Service to Society Award
- Outstanding Service to Bradford Schools Award (Non-BHS Graduates welcome!)

Qualifications

- Must be a graduate or have been enrolled in BHS for the Distinguished Achievement and Service Awards.
- Must have given exceptional contributions to Bradford Schools for the Outstanding Service Award.
- All nominees must have been out of school for a minimum of 10 years.

The awards will be given to the eleventh group of alumni during the spring of 2016. Nominations are being taken by the Distinguished Alumni Committee until January 31st. Anyone may nominate a person for an award providing the nominee meets all the qualifications previously described. A committee will be appointed to score for the nominees presented. Nominees not chosen will be reconsidered for the next year. All decisions are final.
