

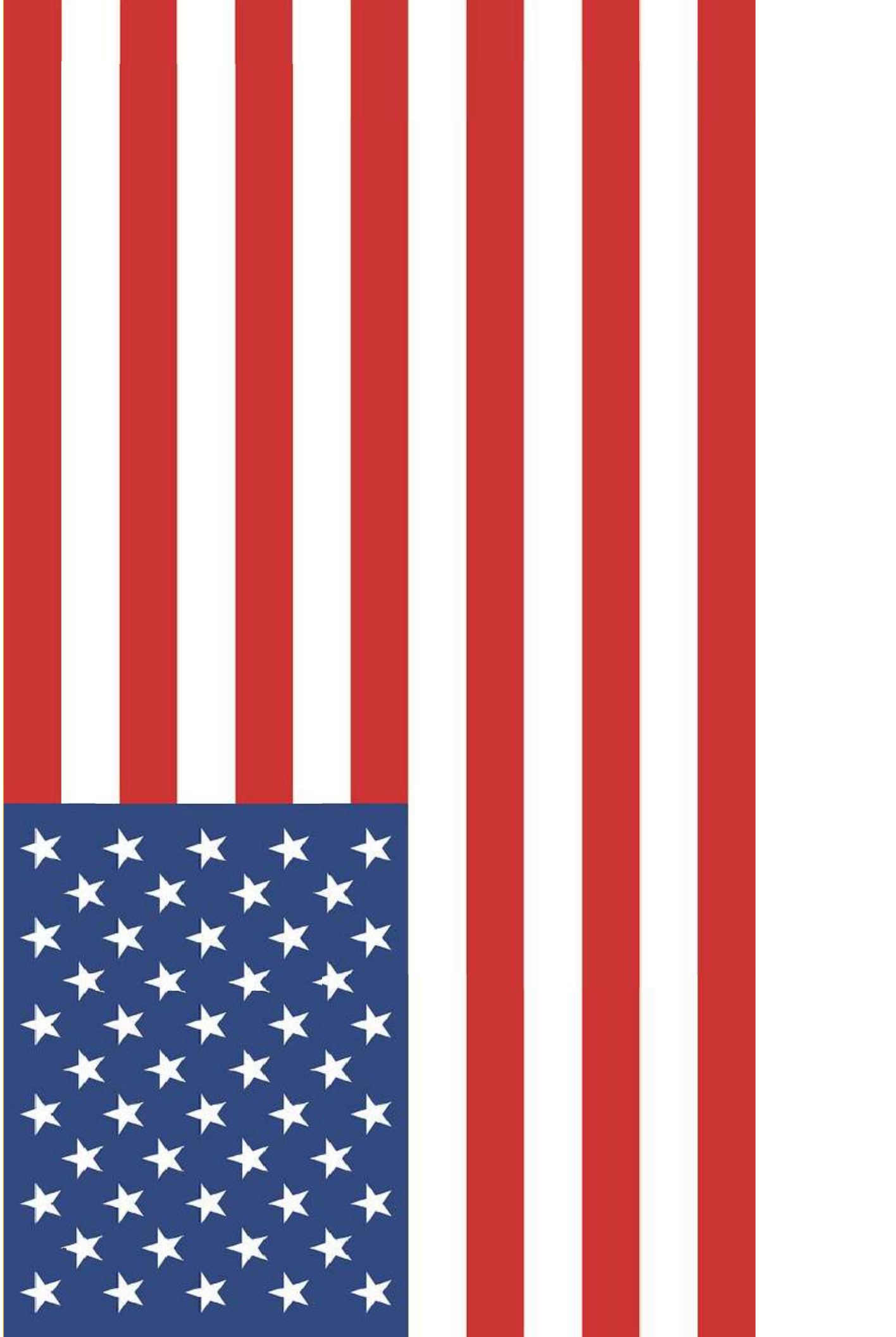

Course of Study Changes

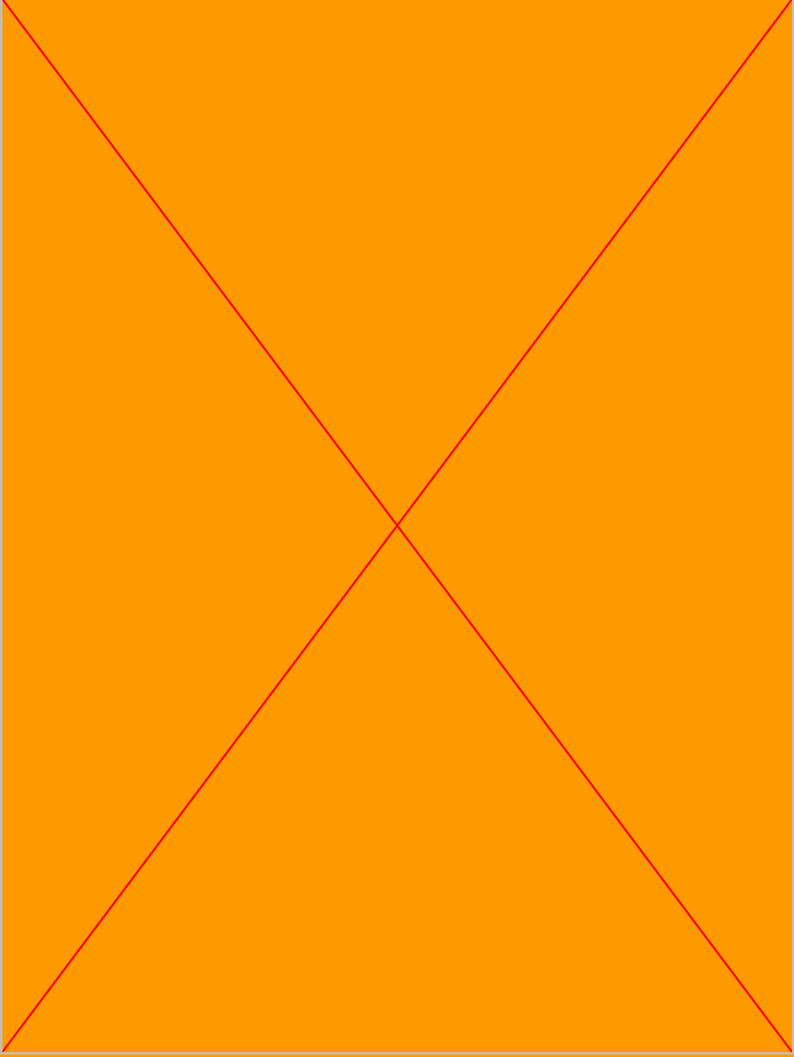
- Updated the following courses that are no long CCP available.

 - Adding Western Civilization to 1500, History of the Supreme Court/Law, FFA Leadership, Marketing, and Small Business Management

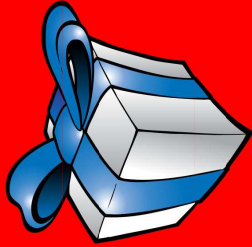
