Child Sexual Abuse Prevention

- Due to Erin's Law, school districts are required to provide sexual abuse prevention in grades K-6 annually starting in the 2023-2024 school year.
- The school also has to provide counseling/resources for those sexually abused.
- The information provided in the program CANNOT connect to organizations that provide, promote, counsel, or make referrals for abortion or abortion-related services.
- You can teach the class in health or any other subject.
- Students may opt out of the program.

- It is a state-approved program.
- It has several developmentally appropriate videos such as safe and unsafe touch.





Total Solar Eclipse Path through Ohio April 8, 2024


















NORTH ELEVATION
