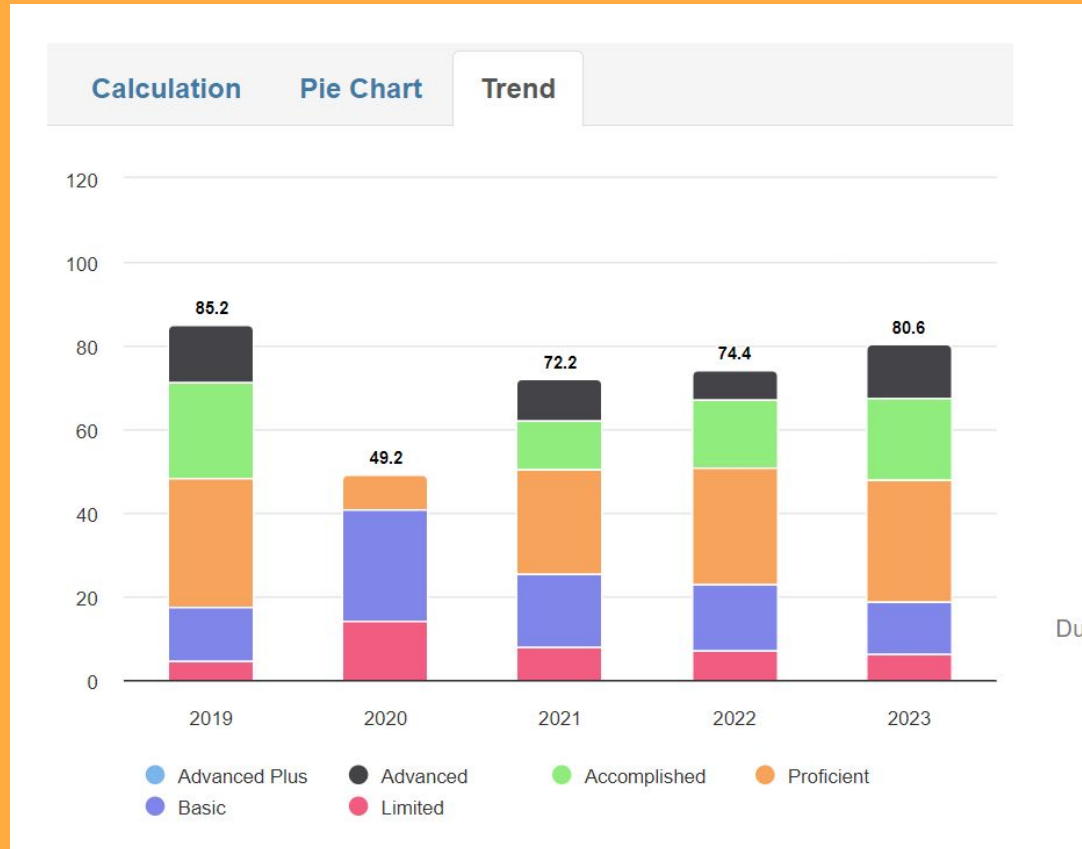

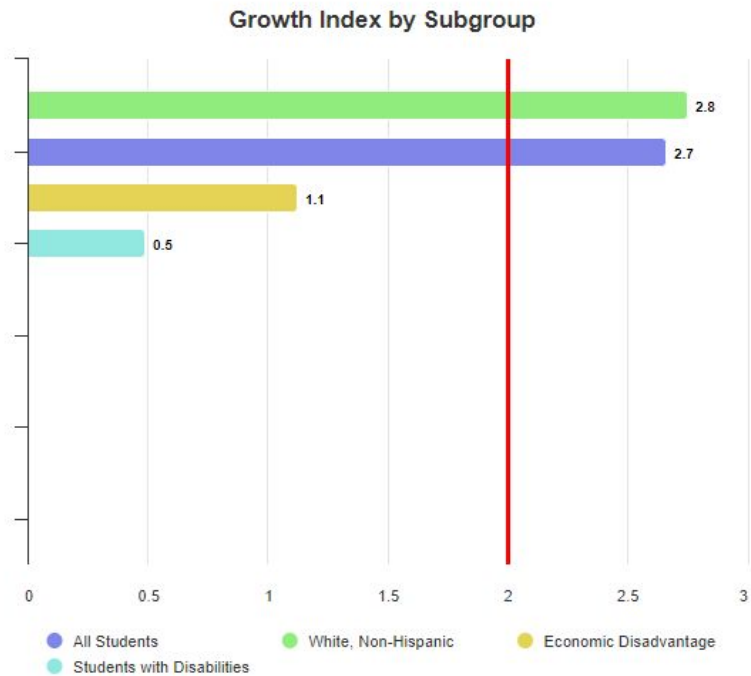

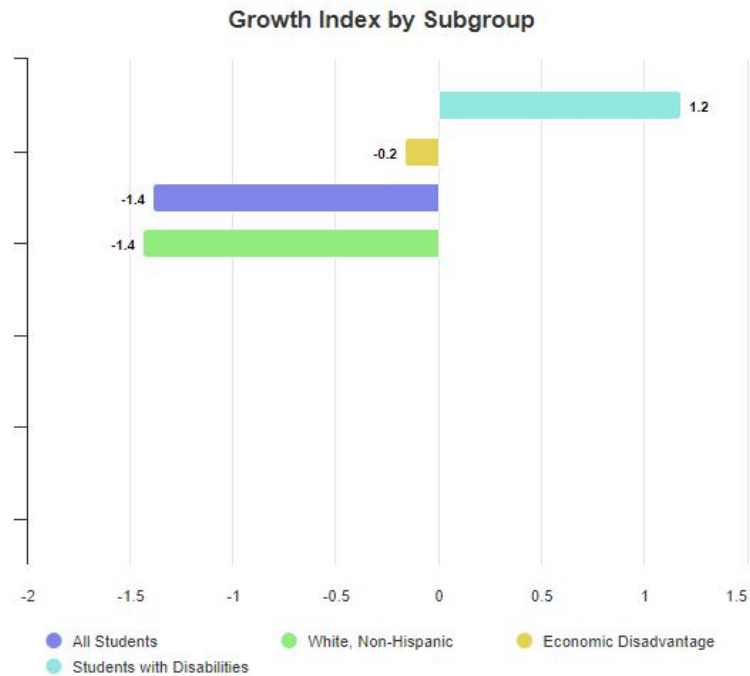

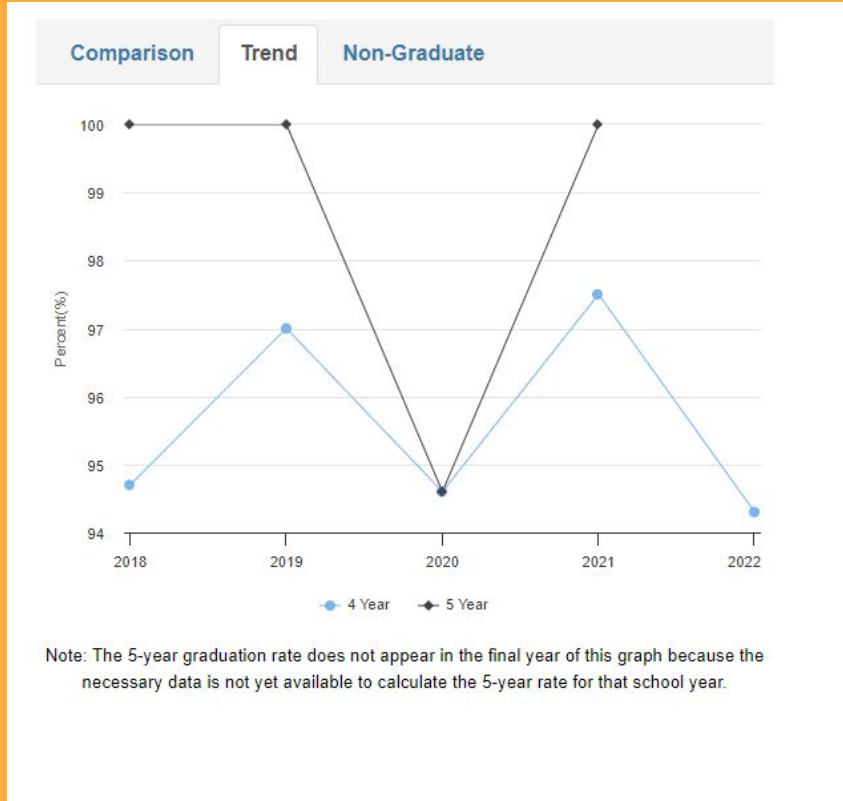
English Language Arts Growth



Math Growth

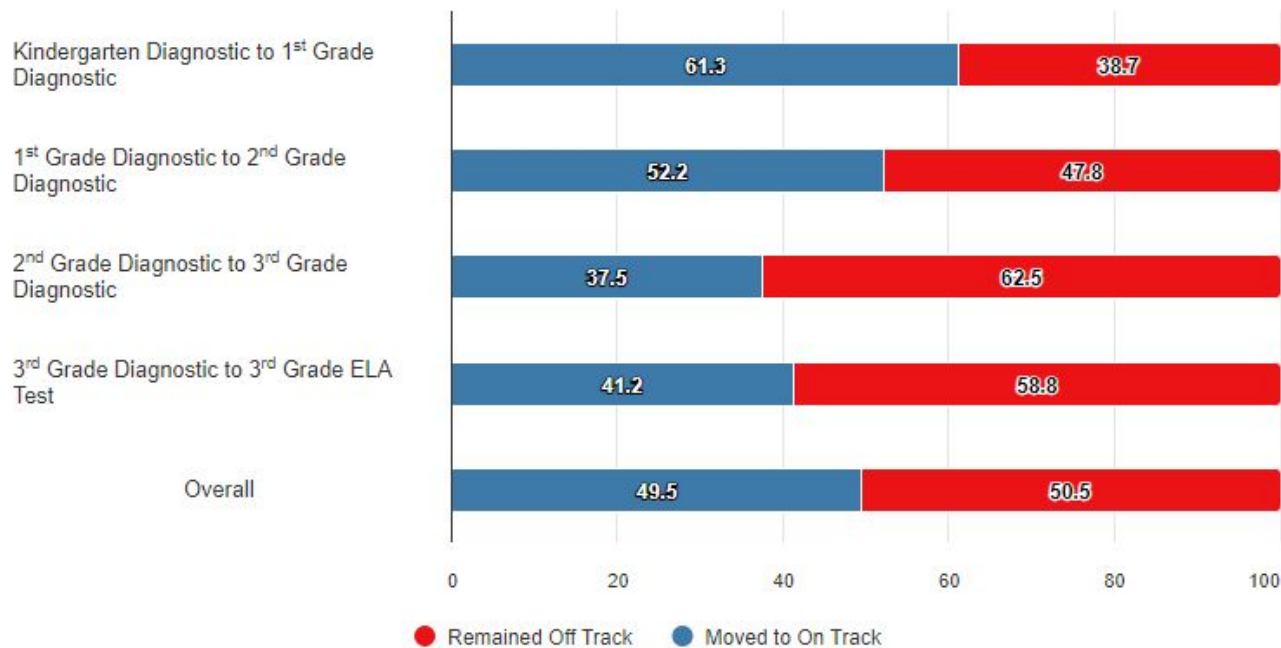


Graduation Rate Trend Data

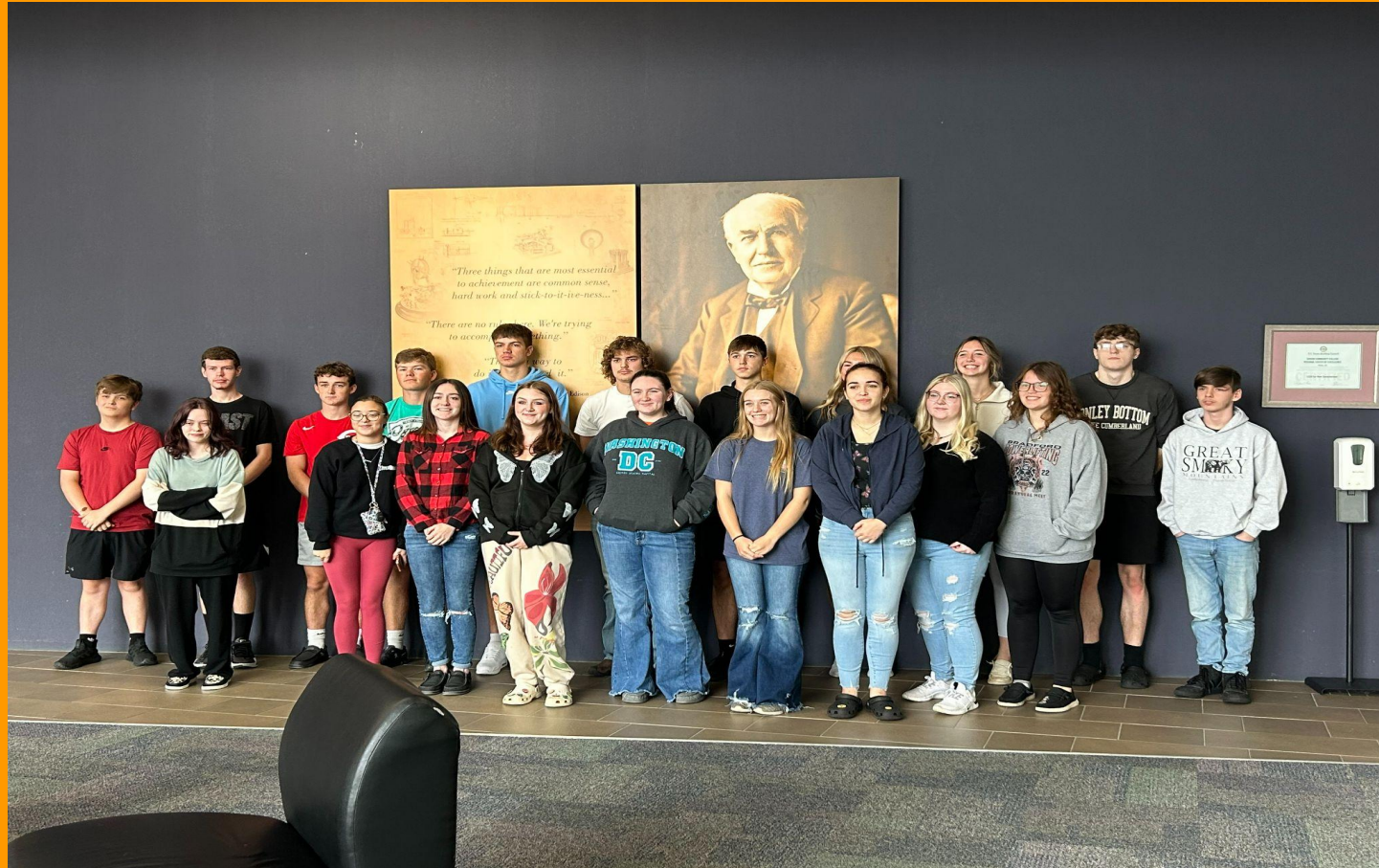


3rd Grade ELA State Testing
