

Scholarship Overview (2024-2025)

- Introduction:** The name of the merit-based, non-renewable scholarship herein created shall be known as the "Mote & Associates, Inc. Scholarship." The intention of the Mote & Associates, Inc. Scholarship is to assist commendable students in the attainment of their post high school education in a career in the field of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study. The objective of the scholarship is (1) to encourage studies in the field of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study, (2) to provide additional incentive and career motivation in the field of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study, (3) to enhance and promote the professions of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study, and (4) to award the scholarship to a student to further their education and enhance their employability in the field of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study.
