# OHIO BUDGET REDUCTIONS



The School was notified on May 6th, 2020, that every district in Ohio would be reduced in the last 6 weeks of the year

Bradford Exempted School District is being decreased a total \$ 75,467 prior to June 30, 2020



Bradford District's number is based from the 2019 Average Daily Membership and the State Share of funding of nearly 64.50%. Our district is very dependent on the State of Ohio for money to operate daily



A disproportionate funding model was used which benefit districts like Bradford, that have a population with a lower median income. Levies will create a large financial burden on these residents.

Access to CARES grant will generate funding for the district to be used in the ODE Federal model which will be restricted funding with additional rules
