Background:

- A. The Board previously identified a need to construct a new bus storage building to facilitate District bussing operations.

- 5. Recommend the sale of athletic/misc. equipment which is no longer usable and deemed obsolete by the school district and will be sold on the approved website of PublicSurplus.com in an internet auction.
